Services & Trainings

GLYS WNY offers various trainings to ensure schools, organizations and our community have a better understand of the LGBTQ+ community and how to best serve our youth.

All trainings start at a base rate of \$100 per hour and all trainings are at least one hour long to allow thorough explanation and understanding of baseline concepts.

The trainings we currently offer are as follows:

- **LGBTQ+ Issues and Concerns**
 - Covers common concerns and themes when working with LGBTQ+ youth
- **Safe Space Training**
 - Recommended for schools and youth serving community organizations
 - If you are a school in WNY you may be eligible for compensation from BOCES
 - This training meets NYS requirements for teachers and school employees
- **Interactive: LGBTQ+ Cultural Humility Training**
 - This interactive training allows trainees to really participate in the conversation and self assess their own implicit biases surrounding the LGBTQ+ community
 - This training is recommended for smaller groups where all can be involved
